WHO IS PROVIDING THIS WARRANTY AGAINST DEFECTS

WHO IS COVERED

Old Skool Speed Shop warranty obligations for any THR engine is limited to the original purchaser of the engine. This warranty is not transferable.

WARRANTY PERIOD

The warranty period for the engine is 12 months from date of purchase.

HOW TO MAKE A CLAIM UNDER THIS WARRANTY

To make a claim under this warranty you must before the expiration of the warranty period contact us immediately upon first noticing any defect in the engine on 0412109625 or sales@oldskoolspeedshop.com.au. You must also complete the attached Warranty Claim Form and submit the Form together with the required documentation to Old Skool Speed Shop. Authorisation and instructions are required before any disassembly or repairs are initiated to diagnose the failure.

Note: (1) Your failure to call Old Skool Speed Shop immediately upon first noticing the defect in the engine and receive authorisation before any repair work is performed will invalidate your warranty claim.

(2) Your warranty claim will also be invalidated if during the warranty period you notice a defect in the engine and you do not immediately stop using the engine and take all reasonable steps to prevent any further damage to the engine.

WARRANTY COVERAGE

When you submit a warranty claim with valid and properly documented paperwork proving you are the original purchaser of the engine, we will, at our option and sole discretion, repair or replace the defective component(s) covered by this warranty. Any component(s) we replace under this warranty will be considered part of the original engine. When an engine is correctly and completely installed, Old Skool Speed Shop will cover defects, subject to the exclusions and limitations identified in this warranty, in our materials and workmanship during the warranty period, as solely determined by us.

WHO IS RESPONSIBLE FOR EXPENSES ASSOCIATED WITH THE WARRANTY CLAIM?

In relation to any claim made by you under this warranty, you are responsible for the expenses associated with the claim including but not limited to towing charges, fluids, refrigerant, gas, filters, lay-up time, lodging, car or truck rental or any other substitute transportation, storage, telephone charges, travel and installation and reinstallation of the engine.

BELOW ARE COMPONENTS COVERED AND NOT COVERED UNDER THIS WARRANTY:

COVERED ENGINE COMPONENTS

Engine block and cylinder heads, all internally lubricated parts of the engine, including pistons, piston rings, piston pins, crankshaft and main bearings, connecting rods and bearings, camshafts and camshaft bearings, timing chain and gears, intake and exhaust valves and seals, valve springs, oil pump, push rods, rocker arms, valve stem seals and hydraulic lifters, to the extent that the original engine contains the referenced warranted

part. Parts that require normal manufacturers recommended replacement intervals are not covered under this warranty.

NOT COVERED ENGINE COMPONENTS

Those engine components specifically not listed including, but not limited to, parts, air filters, oil filters, clutch disc, pressure plate, etc., that are required to be replaced as a part of a normal vehicle maintenance schedule are not covered under this warranty. Alternators, starters, distributors, fuel pumps, fuel injection systems are separately warranted by the component manufacturer. WHAT IS NOT COVERED

- A.** Damage as a result of the use of fuel with octane rating less than **98 octane**.
- B.** Any engine, which has been improperly installed or fails because of defects of inefficiency of parts or units not furnished with the engine, abuse, alteration, improper use, neglect, or damage as a result of overheating, lack of maintenance, fuel contamination, lack of lubrication, or damage resulting from a collision. Operation of such an impaired vehicle will void the warranty.
- C.** Any engine operated under conditions causing greater than normal wear, or used for purposes for which it was not originally designed. Oil consumption due to fuel wash is not covered.
- D.** Routine, regularly required maintenance such as lubrication, changing and maintaining filters, engine tune-up, belts and hoses, any type of fluids or any other normal maintenance service that all vehicles require.
- E.** Melted or broken pistons due to detonation or preignition, cracked blocks or heads due to overheating, damage caused by foreign objects or debris dropped or drawn into cylinders or crankcase. Any damage due to clogged oil coolers.
- F.** Installation of the engine in a vehicle equipped with insufficient vehicle systems that do not allow for proper operation of the engine package (i.e. cooling system, oil system, fuel system, air induction, accessory drive, exhaust, etc.). Old Skool Speed Shop warranty will be voided and any repairs performed by Old Skool Speed Shop will be at the customer's expense. If you have any questions regarding improper engine system requirements, call 0412 109 625.
- G.** Covered component(s) being tampered with or altered from their original configuration as delivered by old Skool Speed Shop, disassembling or reassembling of the engine assembly, or provided components, including but not limited to calibration modifications to the ignition system or fuel delivery system.
- H.** Fires, flood, riots, acts of war or terrorism, theft, vandalism, natural disasters and acts of god are not covered.
- I.** Towing charges, fluids, refrigerant, gas, filters, lay-up time, lodging, car or truck rental or any other substitute transportation, storage, telephone charges, travel, damage to personal property, commercial loss, loss of revenue, or other matters not specifically included.
- J.** Gaskets not installed by THR Developments are the responsibility of the installer and are not covered under this warranty.
- K.** Installation and Reinstallation of engine.
- L.** Any part of the vehicles drive train which fails and causes damage to other parts of the drive train or vehicle.
- M.** Any part of the vehicle's drive train which fails and is the direct cause of engine damage.

WARRANTY DISCLAIMER/EXCLUSIONS/LIMITATIONS

This warranty shall be excluded and a claim shall be declined if the manufacture's heat tabs and sealing tags have been altered from manufacturer, tampered with or removed.

This warranty shall be limited in duration to the warranty period and the warranty coverage described herein.

This warranty covers only defects in material or workmanship, and does not apply to the vehicle in which the engine is installed, any exterior engine component(s), clutch or transmission. This is not a performance warranty and does not cover any vehicle in which the engine is installed. This warranty only covers those specific components listed under warranty coverage. Except as provided in this warranty and to the extent permitted by law, Old Skool Speed Shop is not responsible for any loss or damage arising from the use of the engine, loss of use of the engine, loss of profits or revenue or for any resulting indirect or consequential loss or damage including loss or damage for personal injury or death, or for any breach of warranty or condition.

THIS WARRANTY IS ADDITIONAL TO OTHER WARRANTIES YOU MAY HAVE UNDER THE LAW

The benefits provided to you by this warranty are in addition to other rights and remedies available to you under the law.

IN THE EVENT THAT THE AUSTRALIAN CONSUMER LAW APPLIES TO YOUR PURCHASE

Our goods come with guarantees that cannot be excluded under the Australian Consumer Law. You are entitled to replacement or refund for a major failure and compensation for any reasonably foreseeable loss or damage. You are also entitled to have the goods repaired or replaced if the goods fail to be of acceptable quality and that failure does not amount to a major failure.

- ENGINE SERIAL NUMBER

BELOW FORM MUST BE COMPLETED IN FULL TO SUPPORT YOUR WARRANTY CLAIM WITH US. PLEASE ENSURE CLAIM FORM IS SIGNED BEFORE SUBMITTING.
